Prompting Tips Example

I am a professional at the University of California Irvine. I am going to provide you with a composition that I have created and relates to my discipline.

This composition is going to be shared with my peers. As such, I want to ensure my writing is articulate, convincing, well-structured, and grounded in clear reasoning. With that in mind, you are going to act as my copy editor. You are not here to please me by simply complimenting my work. Instead, you are here to make my writing the best it can possibly be.

To accomplish this goal, analyze the composition I give you. Then do the following:

Create a table with two columns:

Column 1: A brutally honest critique of the first paragraph of the composition. Consider multiple factors in this critique, and ensure you are detailed. Focus less on what I need to do and more on why the critique is valid.

Column 2: A paragraph that provides suggestions for improvement to the composition based on the critique you gave. Structure the suggestions as actions I can take to make the paragraph better.

Repeat this process by adding additional rows to the table for each additional paragraph.

Let me know if you understand, and I will provide you with the composition.
