






NCCI Learning Framework Overview

Key Concepts of NCCI Learning Framework

Five primary concepts make up the NCCI Learning Framework, as designed by the Education Council.

PILLAR

Primary domains of knowledge. The framework offers three domains deemed as central knowledge topics of the organization.

CORE AREA OF FOCUS

Specific subtopics within a domain. There are multiple categories of core knowledge within each domain. The framework is highly integrated, and a core area of knowledge may have application to one or more pillars.

COMPETENCIES


A narrowed focus of skill development within the core area of focus. A competency as a description of the knowledge, skills and abilities essential within each core area.

SCOPE OF IMPACT

Application of learning with different stakeholders throughout colleges and universities. Educational content will focus on Individual, Organizational, Institutional, and Higher Educational Excellence.

PROFICIENCY LEVEL

A continuum of progressive levels of learning in both theory and practice applying educational content in the workplace.

Following Submission Guidelines and Deadlines


Importance of Submission Guidelines

Following submission guidelines is essential to ensure your proposal is reviewed by the selection committee.

Meeting Deadlines

Meeting deadlines is also crucial to the consideration of your proposal.





Clarity and Coherence

Clear and Concise

Use language that is easy to understand and avoid unnecessary jargon or technical terms.

Coherent and Well-Organized

Logical flow of ideas that makes it easy for the reader to follow.

Free from Errors and Inconsistencies

Check for spelling and grammar mistakes, as well as inconsistencies in formatting or style.


