


Getting There



- Airport: Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International
 - 14 miles from conference center/hotel
- Transportation:
 - Public MARTA (Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority):
 - Airport to hotel is 30 minutes by train; leaves every 6 minutes




- Approx \$3
